## Program Descriptions

<p><u>Jumpstart: Get in the Game</u> Jumpstart is an active program designed to get kids up and active. This can be through unstructured playground games, field games, and organized sports.</p>	<p><u>Junior Chef</u> Junior Chef is a cooking program that covers healthy eating, safety in the kitchen and trying new and interesting foods. This program will focus on creating culturally diverse meals.</p>	<p><u>Enviro Heroes (Off-Site Program)</u> Enviro Heroes is a great program for members to learn about gardening, taking care of our earth, and giving back to the community. This is an off-site program.</p>
<p><u>Great Adventures (Off-Site Program).</u> This program has a strong emphasis on outdoor recreational activities. Members will have the opportunity to explore and discover the outdoors, recreation and culture. This is an off-site program. Please note the program times: Children will not be able to be picked up early from this program.</p>	<p><u>JUMP Math C</u> This is a math literacy program that is designed to instill confidence in youth and to increase success in school. JUMP Math C is for children in Gr. 5-6. JUMP Math is a full year commitment. Children registered for JUMP Math will not be eligible to register in competing programs in future blocks.</p>	<p><u>Between Generations (Half-Day Program)</u> In this program, children will be visiting the Gilchrist Manor (beside VSLC) to help foster relationships with seniors. Through playing games, making crafts, and sharing stories, children and senior will make intergenerational friendships.</p>
<p><u>Drama-Rama</u> This is a dramatic art program that focuses on expression and creativity. Members will learn new acting and performing techniques.</p>	<p><u>AKA (Active Kids are Awesome)</u> AKA is a program designed for children who like to be active, but want more than sports. Through dance, yoga, playground games, and more, children will gain skills in a variety of activity.</p>	<p><u>Money Money Money</u> Money Money Money is a program designed to help kids raise money for the club to get the things that they really want.</p>
<p><u>Teen Sports</u> Teen Sports is a Round-Robin League playing against the other club locations. Focus is on skill development and sportsmanship. For Spring Block, this program will be open to children in Gr. 6.</p>	<p><u>Torch</u> In this program, club children are active and engaged in the community. Torch helps kids develop leadership skills and self-esteem in a respectful, diversified environment.</p>	<p><u>Imagination Station</u> This program focuses on the fine arts and expression of creativity. Participants will have the opportunity to create several art projects, play drama games, explore dance, and other creative outlets.</p>
<p><u>Jr. Sports (Off-Site Program)</u> Jr. Sports is a round-robin league amongst the other 6 Club locations. This program focuses on sportsmanship and skill development. This is an off-site program.</p>	<p><u>Keystone (Off-Site Program)</u> Keystone, a BGC national program, helps kids 14 and older channel their energy in a positive direction. It focuses on leadership, education and career development, economic and political awareness, and social recreation. This is an off-site program.</p>	<p><u>Teen Drop In</u> This is a safe and welcoming place for youth to hang out. Teens will participate in a variety of activities which will help them gain confidence, self-esteem and provide them with new skills for life. For Spring Block, this program will be open to children in Gr. 6.</p>
